

# Report on distribution of 250 tablets for the period from *May 2, 2025* to *June 12, 2025*



On May 2, 2025, we received a transfer in the amount of USD 49980. (File 1).

On May 02, 2025, we exchanged US dollars for Hryvnia at the rate of UAH 41.2850 and received a total of UAH 2 057 208,63 (File 2).

On May 22, 2025, we paid for 250 tablets in the amount of UAH 1 989 208,00 (File 3).

Accounting expenses amounted to UAH 15000  
Organizational costs amounted to UAH 30000  
May 22, 2025 Payment for printed products - UAH 2 835,00 (File 4).

Transportation costs - UAH 20165,63.



On May 22, 2025, we distributed 70 tablets to children from the families of fallen soldiers, students of grades 1-5, from the Stryisky community of the Lviv region.

On May 29, 2025, we distributed 73 tablets to 6-11 grade students from families of fallen soldiers of Stryisky community of the Lviv region.



On June 12, we visited the city of Drohobych and distributed 104 tablets to children from families of fallen soldiers, those missing in action, and those currently in captivity.





# Drohobych



After our last distribution, we had three tablets left. A few days later, we received a request from a family from Lviv, whose child attends the 45th school - the same school we visited back in 2022.

The family moved to Lviv from Novoyavorivsk. Their father was killed in the war actions in the eastern part of Ukraine, back in 2023. The family has three children, and one of them is of school age. We decided to give them one of the tablets.





Also, after the distribution of tablets in Drohobych, two more families contacted us. For various reasons, they had previously concealed from their children the fact that their fathers were missing. We checked these situations and decided to give tablets to these children as well.

All in all, we were not merely distributing tablets – we were delivering care, remembrance, and hope. Each of the 250 tablets became more than just a learning tool for a child from a family of a fallen, missing, or captured defender. It became a symbol – a sign that they are remembered, their loss is acknowledged, and their dignity is honored.

We would like to express our deepest and most heartfelt gratitude to you – the foundation, the organizers, and everyone who contributed to the fundraising, who believed, planned, inspired, and supported it. Thanks to your daily work, your humanity, and your big hearts, this initiative became possible.
